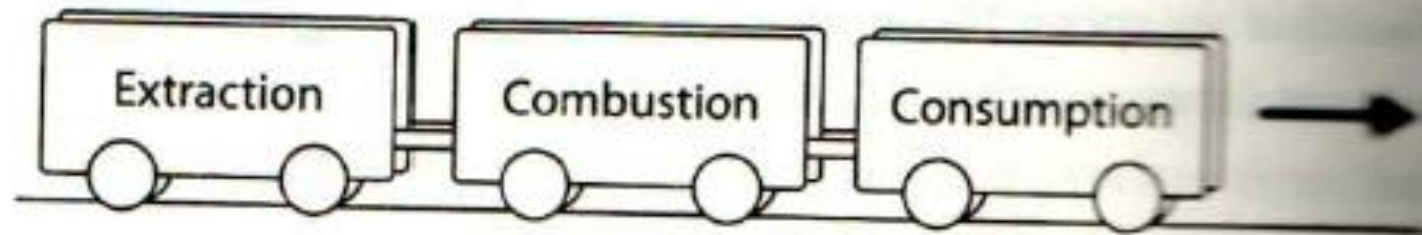


Anne Chapman
